**CHAPTER 3: REVENUE AND FINANCE  
SUBCHAPTER 1: SALES AND USE TAX**

**AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 3 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED REVENUE AND FINANCE,  
CONSISTING OF CHAPTER 3 SUBCHAPTER 1, ENTITLED SALES AND USE TAX.**

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Florence does ordain as follows:

**ARTICLE 1.** Unless otherwise expressly stated herein, all references to section and chapter numbers are to be those of the Florence County Ordinances.

**ARTICLE 2.** Chapter 3, Revenue and Finances, Subchapter 1, Sales and Use Taxes is amended to read as follows:

**TITLE**

This ordinance may be cited as the Florence County Sales and Use Tax Ordinances

**AUTHORITY**

This ordinance is enacted pursuant to, and in conformity with, the provisions of subchapter V of Chapter 77 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and acts amendatory thereto.

**PURPOSE**

The County of Florence does hereby elect to establish and impose a county sales and use tax at the rate of 0.5% to be used only for the purpose of directly reducing the property tax levy of Florence County.

**CONFORMITY TO STATE LAW**

It is the expressed intent of the County of Florence that the construction, administration and application of this ordinance in all situations shall conform to the laws of the State of Wisconsin in all ways and shall be so construed, applied and administered.

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

This ordinance shall continue in effect, in the manner provided for by law. This ordinance shall expire and no longer be in force as of **December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021** at 11:59 P.M.
