INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING  
GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS

\$13,200,000

- I. BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the School District of Florence County, Florence County, Wisconsin, that there shall be issued, pursuant to Chapter 67, Wisconsin Statutes, General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$13,200,000 for the purpose of paying the costs of improvements, renovations and additions to the Middle/High School building including upgrades to the HVAC, electrical, plumbing and telecommunications systems; roof, window and door replacements; a secure building entry; classroom and kitchen additions; renovations to the 1930's section and demolition of the two-story 1956 section of said building; and equipment acquisition related to said projects.
