

The Florence County Personnel Committee met for a special meeting on June 14th, 2016 at the Courthouse. The meeting was called to order by the Chair. Members present were Supervisors Bomberg, Johnson, Kelley, Steber, and Theer. Absent: None.

Moved by Supervisor Johnson, seconded by Supervisor Steber to approve the Agenda as presented. Ayes: Five (5). Nays: None (0). Motion carried.

Moved by Supervisor Steber, seconded by Supervisor Kelley approval to offer employment to candidate #1 for the Land Conservation Technician and candidate #1 for the AIS Coordinator positions as recommended by the Land Conservation Committee. Ayes: Five (5). Nays: None (0). Motion carried.

Rich Wolosyn, Zoning/Recycling/Land Conservation Administrator, explained the Land Information Grant to the Committee and the time frame to complete the work. He asked to increase hours for Deputy Laurie Boren and Deputy Donna Liebergen through the term of the grant, but not to exceed 15 hours per week for each employee. Any over time and time off benefits will be paid through the grant. He also asked that if the two employees work on weekends they work together for safety purposes.

Moved by Supervisor Johnson, seconded by Supervisor Steber approval to offer extra hours to both Boren and Liebergen through the term of the Land Information Grant. When working on weekends, they must work together for safety purposes. Ayes: Five (5). Nays: None (0). Motion carried.

Moved by Supervisor Steber, seconded by Supervisor Kelley approval to advertise an interview for one to two vacant Highway positions with revised job descriptions as recommended by the Highway Committee. Ayes: Five (5). Nays: None (0). Motion carried.

There being no further business and on a motion made, seconded, and carried the meeting was adjourned.
