

Employment Opportunities

Florence County Land Conservation Department is hiring grant-based, summer Seasonal Staff These positions may require working weekends and non-standard hours. Applicants must have a willingness to learn, along with a friendly and helpful personality that promotes a positive respectful experience for the public and co-workers while demonstrating a genuine interest in preserving water quality. Seasonal staff will follow Florence County's Personnel Policy requirements. **All positions are subject to grant requirements, and are classified as Seasonal Employees (LTE) with no benefits.** Mandatory paid training for all positions will be provided.

Road-Stream Crossing Technician (RSXT): Two positions at 35-40 hours per week based on grant funding. This work will utilize the Great Lakes Road Stream Crossing Inventory protocols and the use of additional technology to document culverts and other road-stream crossings in the county.

The successful applicant will work with Land Conservation staff to survey road-stream crossings in the county. These positions are field-based.

Applicants must:

- Be at least 18 years old.
- Possess a valid driver's license, have transportation, and be willing to work at remote sites.
- Complete physical exertion related to rough terrain, carrying equipment, wading in shifting lake/stream beds and includes repetitive upper body motions, bending and twisting.
- Work in and around fast-moving water, rough terrain, and in varying weather conditions.
- Work independently and as part of a team.
- Have good written, communication, and technical skills.
- Knowledge of survey methods and equipment is helpful but not required.

Applications will be accepted until 4:00 p.m. Thursday April 27, 2023. Positions are expected to run to May to October but may vary by grant needs. **Wage:** \$20.00/hour.
