Information requested on this application must be provided to obtain a retail food establishment license. Personal identifiable information you provide may be used for purposes other than that for which it was collected. Wis. Stat § 15.04 (1)(m). Licenses are not transferable between persons or locations. Licenses expire annually on June 30th; unless issued after April 1st, which will expire on June 30th of the following year. A late fee will apply to establishments that fail to meet license renewal deadline. The license fee is not prorated for partial license years. A license shall not be issued and you are not authorized to operate without a pre-inspection.

An operating without a license fee will be issued for all facilities that are operating without a current license. A re-inspection fee will be assessed based on the license category for any required re-inspection. Within **30 days** after receiving a complete application for a license, the department or its agent shall either approve the application and issue a license or deny the application. If the application for a license is denied, the department or its agent shall give the applicant reasons, in writing, for the denial. Your signature below will acknowledge that you have received a copy of the code or information as to where to obtain a copy and will comply with all applicable Wisconsin Administrative Code(s). and you wish to apply for a Retail Food Establishment license under Wis. Stat § 97.30.

Retail Food Establishment-Serving Meals- Complexity Category Calculator

A retail food establishment serving meals are placed into four categories based on food safety risks. A retail food establishment serving meals that are pre-packaged and TCS (requires time/temperature control) only prepares individually wrapped, single food servings, which are packaged off-premises by a licensed food processor, with the on-premise activity limited to heating and serving (Ex. Whole frozen pizzas). The three other categories (simple, moderate and complex) use a point system to determine the license complexity category.

The complexity category is needed to complete you license application.
