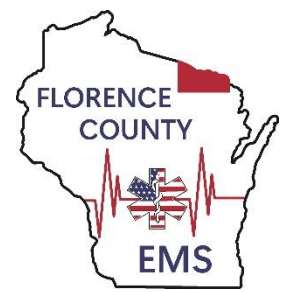


Florence County, Wisconsin

The County of Florence, Wisconsin invites applications for Licensed Emergency Medical Services Staffing positions for the Florence County EMS – Countywide System.

Position Summary: Under the direction of the EMS Director, who reports directly to the Law Enforcement & Personnel Committee, EMS General Staff will perform duties associated with providing rescue services and pre-hospital emergency medical care to the sick and injured in accordance with all applicable laws, regulations, and policies.

Education: High School degree or GED.

Licensure, Registration and/or Certification: Current National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) or current Emergency Medical Services license issued by the State of Wisconsin for the position level being applied for (EMR/EMT/AEMT/Paramedic). NREMT certification preferred. Minimum of Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Providers CPR & AED certification issued by the American Heart Association (AHA). Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) for applicants licensed to the AEMT level and above. A valid, unrestricted driver's license issued by the Division of Motor Vehicles.

Requirements: Please see full job description for individual licensure levels (EMR, EMT, AEMT & Paramedic) posted on the County's website for a complete list of knowledge, skills and abilities qualified candidates will possess.
