### Sheriff Monthly Report

Sheriff Miller presented the Sheriff's Department monthly report. He informed the Committee that the month of July 2020 recorded 491 calls for service, 12 arrests, 80 citations, 25 warnings, 159 traffic stops, 11 accidents, 15 K9 deployments and 114 calls received to 911 services. Inmate Housing fee's, Sheriff's fee's, jail reimbursement and fines totaled \$7,268.81.
