EMS Dispatch

Sheriff Miller called the meeting because he is the Florence County Director of Dispatch and has concerns with the Florence and Aurora Volunteer Rescue Squads providing adequate coverage.

He reported that only half the calls are being answered and the backup Michigan rescue squad is struggling to cover the large area they cover. With the Michigan Rescue Squads, struggling to keep up on the call volume this could result in the possibility of having no coverage when a 911 call comes in to Florence Dispatch. Sheriff Miller is asking the town leaders to come together with a resolution.

All 8 Towns and Rescue Squads were represented. A long discussion took place and it was agreed to meet again with the Towns calling the meeting on January 13, 2021 at the Resource/Visitors Center, 6pm.
