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			<p><i>in CY2020—typically held on school campus after graduation ceremony).</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>AODA Youth Prevention: Provide funding to the Florence School District to support AODA counseling to students by School Guidance Counselor.</i> <p><i>*It should be noted that many prevention activities were planned; however, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, several activities were cancelled and/or were not scheduled. The spending of prevention funding vs. treatment costs is a Statewide concern and being addressed with DHS.</i></p> <p>Alcohol Community Assessment and Action Plan: <i>infographic started but waiting on most recent YRBS data.</i></p> <p>Community Gathering: <i>was hoping to fulfill with Keeping it Real, but instead FCHD has displayed the teen backpack and distributed lock boxes and bags at each COVID-19 vaccine clinic days.</i></p> <p>No cost grant extension- <i>Florence Co was awarded the grant for year 6!
