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Libertas Notes:

Easy to Access Service

Vaping

Nicotine

Marijuana

Opioids and other hard drugs

Contact by phone, website, or in person.

Screening – In Patient withdraw management

Residential Services – Intensive outpatient 10 hours a week (can be done by telehealth)

Use of Veyo medical transport to get to required face to face meetings (not as accessible here in Florence County that is being looked into by HSD)

Peer Support Specialist available by text or phone call 24/7

Assessment – In person meeting, then only needed once annually. Counselor can request in person for drug screening.

4 hours a week than to 1 hour a week group than 1 to 2 times a week.

Dr. Laura Powers can see patients for blockers & partial blockers, but need to see them at least once a year in person.



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There is a drug out that is an injection last 28 days and Libertas is looking to implement this for those eligible for its use.

They do have test strips for 2 types of drugs so people are able to see what they are actually taking. They are seeing patients who are now wanting fentanyl in their drug supply as it gives them a bigger hit so educating them on the dangers of the drug and Dr. are also having to subscribe a higher dose of suboxone because of fentanyl.

What Dr. DePrekel is seeing: 4-5 people, treating with Suboxone which helps with the opioid side but they are also addicted to either Meth or Heroin and suboxone does not assist with that side of the patient's addiction. They get treated for the Opioid but still choose to use other harder drugs.

She had noticed her patients have skin irritation while they are using Meth. She has also noted that a big issue with them getting treatment at facilities is the transportation they do not have reliable transportation that are not people from circles that are still using so they just end right back in the cycle of use.

Drug Vivitrol you need to be clean 48-72 hours to be safe before being put on this drug as it reacts badly.

Note that Libertas has dropped their hospital license which means they no longer able to bill private insurance and only take State Medicaid.

Prevea Hospital system can bill private/ commercial insurance and Medicaid
